Public Meeting on PFAS Testing and Investigation

The State of Vermont will hold a public meeting to provide an update on PFAS testing and investigation work in parts of Bennington and Shaftsbury. The work has focused on neighborhoods in southern Bennington, south of Route 9 and east of Mount Anthony, and in Shaftsbury, mainly around East Road just north of Bennington.

The State is working with its contractor Weston & Sampson. They have completed several rounds of water-supply testing in these areas. Some testing in Shaftsbury was completed by another contractor.

Community members from Bennington, Shaftsbury, and surrounding areas are invited to attend. At the meeting, officials from the Agency of Natural Resources and Department of Health will:

- Share results of the work completed so far
- Discuss planned future work
- Answer questions from residents and other interested community members

All interested members of the public are welcome. There will be additional time at the end of the meeting to discuss Shaftsbury-specific concerns.
