These items don't go in your recycling bin!

Put them in participating store grocery recycling bins in your community:



Film collected by groceries stores and local community collection programs is recycled into Trex® decking material!

Ice bags

Pellet bags

Items with these labels

(#2 or #4 plastic films)

Salt bags

Not Accepted

The following plastic bags & films cannot be recycled in this program and should be discarded in the trash:



"Crinkly" and stiff plastic bags and film that do not stretch



Most food packaging, especially:

- Resealable pouches
- Grape bags (& similar)
- Snack food bags
- Meat & cheese packaging
- Pre-washed salad mix bags
- Chip bags

- · Shiny/metallic foil-lined plastic
- · Candy and granola bar wrappers
- Mesh bags
- Frozen food packaging
- Vacuum seal bags















Bags that are **dirty**, **wet**, or have **paper labels** (cut out paper labels from plastic shipping envelopes and other recyclable bags)




Paper envelopes lined with bubble wrap





Anything labeled with a number other than 2 or 4 (such as 5 or 7) or with strike-through labels:














Mulch & soil bags, agricultural plastic
