

The Board of Directors proposes to incur bonded indebtedness to finance construction of certain capital improvements to the Spinelli Complex at Mount Anthony Union High School, including installation of a new track, lights, and synthetic turf field, together with other costs and expenses of the project ("Project") in an amount not to exceed Three Million 00/100 **Dollars** and (\$3,000,000.00). None of the project is expected to be eligible for state school construction aid and therefore all of the costs of the project, i.e., \$3,000,000, will be the responsibility of the Mount Anthony Union High School District.

Shall bonds of the school district in a principal amount not to exceed Three Million and 00/100 (\$3,000,000.00), subject to reduction from available State or federal funds, if any, be issued to finance construction of capital improvements to the Spinelli Complex (i.e. installation of new track, lights, and synthetic turf field) at Mount Anthony Union High School?

State funds may not be available at the time this project is otherwise eligible to receive State school construction aid. The District is responsible for all costs incurred in connection with any borrowing done in anticipation of State school construction aid.
