

New Vermont Law

Firearms not allowed at Polling Places

(Firearms may be stored in your motor vehicle)



A person shall not knowingly possess a firearm at a polling place or on the walkways to a building in which a polling place is located on an election day.

This applies to:

- Town Clerk's office during the 45 days prior to an election (early voting).
- Any place a municipality has designated to the Secretary of State as a polling place.
