## Superintendent's Report - November, 2025

#### **Burials:**

There have been 3 burials since our last meeting.

#### Lot Sales:

#### **Gravestone Repairs & Maintenance:**

I had the pleasure of working with; Nick, Eric, and Ian from the DPW crew for three days this month. During those three days we were able to completely fix and straighten all the headstone stones, except 3 or 4. I believe 2 will end up being replacements but I will try and fix them in the spring. After we leveled them all we brought in topsoil, and filled a few areas that had collapsed coffins from very old burials and no vaults. We then seeded and laid down hay.

The crew and I worked very hard work on this restoration, and the results speak for themselves — it looks fantastic.
