Meeting Minutes

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Town of Shaftsbury Water Board Meeting

Date of Meeting: Monday, July 21, 2025, at 5:30 PM, in person at Cole Hall and remotely via Zoom.

1. Call to Order:

The meeting came to order at 5:30 PM. Present were board members Zoe Contros Kearl (Chair), Naomi Miller (Vice Chair), Mike Cichanowski, Brad Peacock, Water Dept. Superintendent Josh Brace, Water Board Consultant Art Whitman, Treasurer Melanie Dexter, and Town Administrator Paula Iken.
