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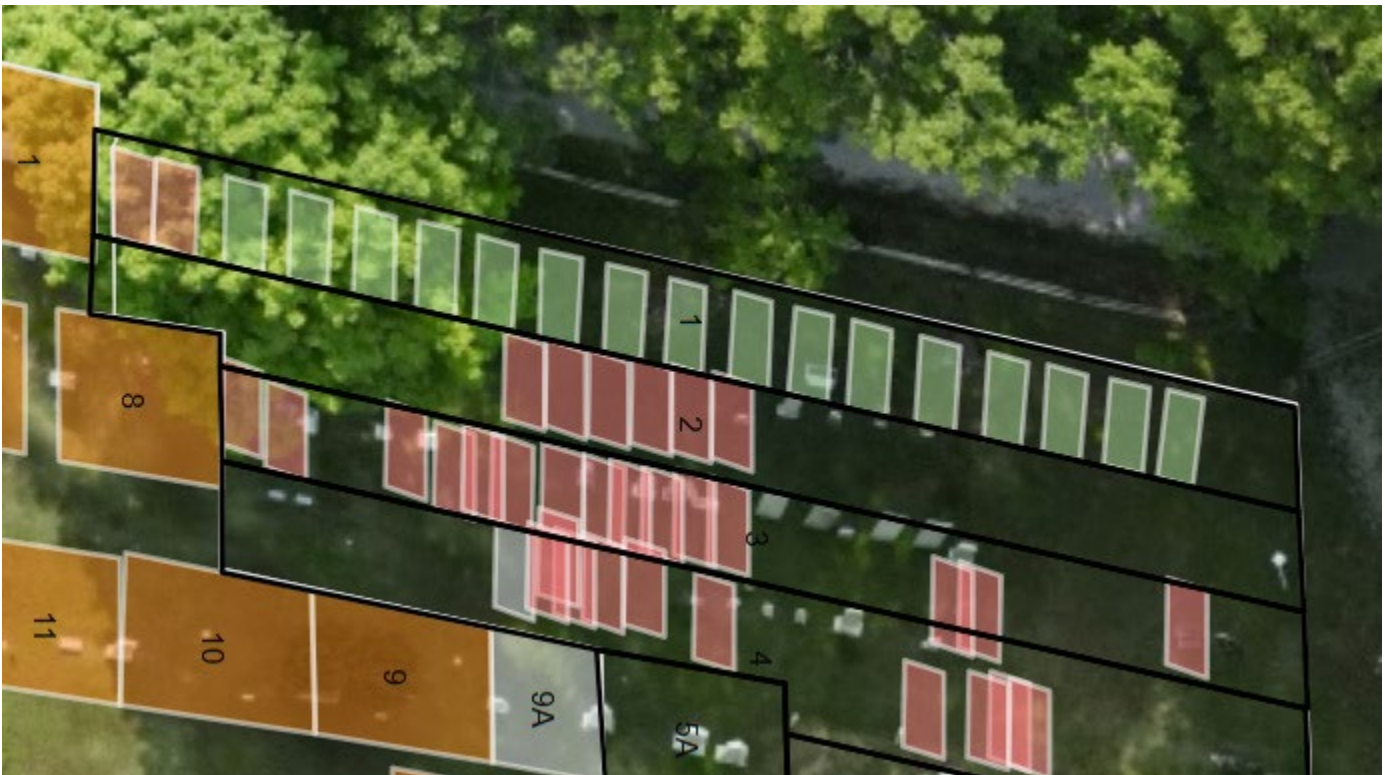

Superintendent's Report - August 5, 2026

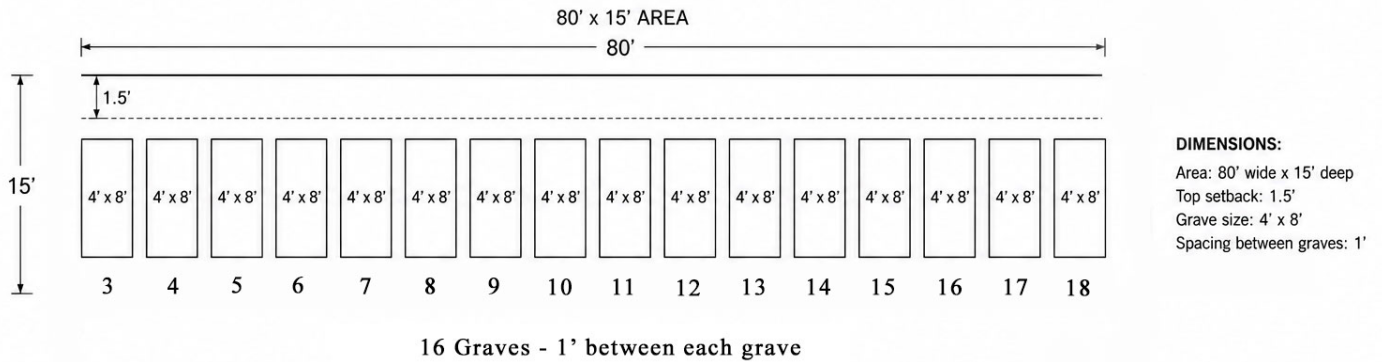
Burials: There were no burials since the last meeting.

Village Fence Cleanup:

On July 2nd I worked with DPW in Village Cemetery on removing the large pile cement posts and rails from the old fence. We also cleaned out each post hole of large rocks. We worked at filling each one with topsoil to ground level. It was 95 degrees – Jay Coonradt was very pleased with the job we did. This should have been done by the fencing company. They told the Town Administrator that they did not have any topsoil because they didn't anticipate the large concrete piles that they pulled out of the ground. Therefore, they were un prepared to finish it off.

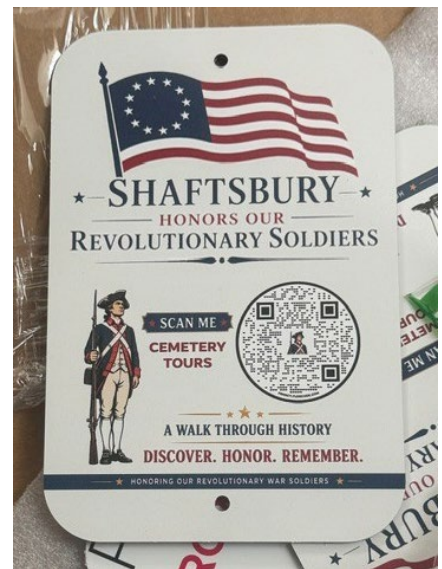


Revolutionary Tours
